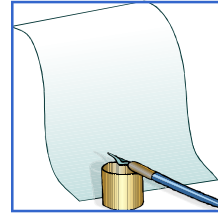

As we begin to prepare for revival with Evangelist Jon Reed on September 27-30, I want to do two things. First of all, I want to challenge you to go over a check-list of items to prepare you to receive what God would have you to receive:

REVIVAL

- Pray everyday for everything and everyone involved in revival.
- Ask God to bind Satan as you prepare.
- Make a list of those you will invite to revival; pray for them; contact them every week by phone, card, e-mail, text, etc. to let them know you are praying for them.
- Look at God's Word daily for Him to speak to you about His Will and direction for you.
- Be positive in all you do—it's catching (by the way, so is negativism).
- Talk to someone each and every day about the Lord and how good He is.
- Practice acts of kindness to those around you, especially to those who are not so kind.
- Ask God to cleanse you as you ask for forgiveness and repent of your sins.
- Ask God to place in your path each day those who need Jesus.

Secondly, I want you to commit to being here with us as often as possible between now and revival. Please pray God will give me the words to speak that we will all hear what God has to say to us, individually and as a body of believers. My messages leading up to revival will be:

August 23rd: "Who Are You...Who Is He?"

September 6th: "Yes, Lord!"

September 13th: "Lord, Here I Am!"
