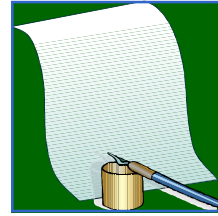

We wonder many times what revival really means and if it will really happen. God is ready for it—He is just waiting for us to cooperate. 2 Chronicles 7:14 says:

*...if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.*

Look with me at the following acrostic for "revival" to give us some beneficial ideas of what we can be doing to prepare ourselves for true, Heaven-sent, Holy Spirit revival to come:

**R**emember all the many blessings God has so richly poured out on you; shouldn't you care enough about others to share Jesus with them?

**E**very person is special to God; shouldn't they be to us also?

**V**alue your life, God does; hey, why not also value the lives of others; pray daily for those you will ask to attend the services.

**I**nvoke all those on your prayer list to the revival services; better yet, go by and pick them up, take them out to eat, then bring them to hear God's Word spoken!

**V**ow now to attend all the revival services you are physically able to; in fact, why not attend all the services you can between now and then; I would love it and I promise you that you will not be hurt by it.

**A**ll have sinned and come short of the glory of God; the wages of sin is death, BUT the gift of God is eternal life!

**L**ast but not least, God loves us and expects us to show that love to others!

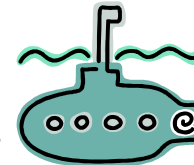

### DIVE DEEP INTO KIDMO

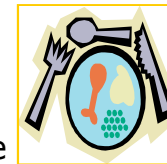
