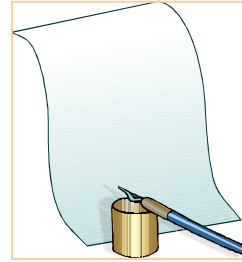

When we are kids our parents give us our "marching orders" as to what is allowed and what is not. Then, when we are older and get a job, our bosses or supervisors give us our "marching orders" as to what is expected of us. Of course, when married, our spouses usually give us their "marching orders". I want us to revisit Jesus' "marching orders" as found in Matthew 28:18-20:

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

You see, Jesus has all power and all authority and when we go "In His Name" we go with that same power and authority! He literally says "As You Go", take the message of hope with you, baptize those who accept, and teach them all the things I have taught you. "As you go" means in every area of your life, wherever you are, regardless of the situation, live out and speak the message of Jesus Christ to all you come in contact with!

D. James Kennedy once said: "While the world

has been multiplying, the Church has been making additions." But Jesus reminds us in Matthew 9:37-38:

Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.³⁸ Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

Question: Why are we not multiplying? Jesus answers this for us: The harvest is truly plentiful, but where are the laborers; we should pray for more laborers!
