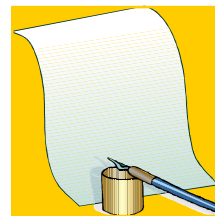

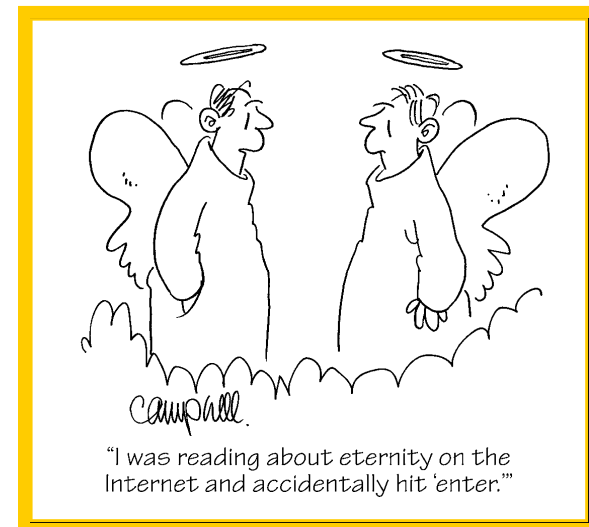
Bro. Phil, what are you trying to say? Simply this: if true revival will come God's people
