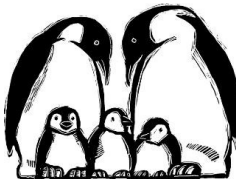

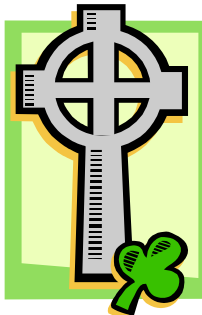

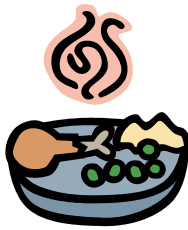

In a seminary missions class, Herbert Jackson told how, as a new missionary, he was assigned a car that would not start without a

push.

After pondering his problem, he devised a plan. He went to the school near his home, got permission to take some children out of class, and had them push his car off. As he made his rounds, he would either park on a hill or leave his car running. He used this ingenious procedure for two years.

Ill health forced the Jackson family to leave, and a new missionary came to that station. When Jackson proudly began to explain his arrangement for getting the car started, the new man began looking under the hood. Before the explanation was complete, the new missionary interrupted, "Why, Dr. Jackson, I believe the only trouble is this loose cable." He gave the cable a twist, stepped into the car, pushed the switch, and to Jackson's astonishment, the engine roared to life.

For two years needless trouble had become routine. The power was there all the time. Only a loose connection kept Jackson from putting the power to work.

J. B. Phillips paraphrases Ephesians 1:19, "How tremendous is the power available to us who believe in God." When we make firm our connection with God, His life and power flow through us.

I would venture to say that the number one question asked among Christians is: "How can I do the work of the ministry when I am not able?" Question:

Does God ask us to do what He doesn't equip us to do? Does He send us to battle without weapons? Does He expect more from us than we can do? No! No! No!

Like the car above, the power was there all the time—only a loose connection kept Jackson from putting it to work! I BELIEVE THAT IS THE PROBLEM OF SO MANY—THE POWER IS THERE (Eph. 1:19 above) BUT THERE IS A LOOSE CONNECTION WITH GOD!

This Sunday will begin our series of meetings for our "Festival For New Life." I believe with all my heart if *you* give God a chance by being here, He will re-connect you to His power source. Every one of us are to be ministers. Each one of us has a spiritual gift. God expects us all to work together as parts of The Body of Christ. Are *you* doing *your* part?
