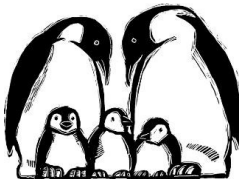

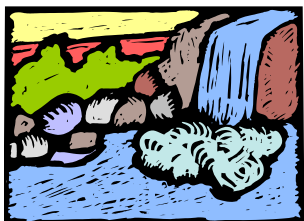

Roger von Oech in his book *A Kick in the Seat of the Pants*, suggests:

Take a look around where you're sitting and find five things that have blue in

them. Go ahead and do it.

With a "blue" mindset, you'll find that blue jumps out at you: a blue book on the table, a blue pillow on the couch, blue in the painting on the wall, and so on...In like fashion, you've probably noticed that after you buy a new car, you promptly see that make of car everywhere. That's because people find what they are looking for.

At times in our lives, God seems strangely absent, but the problem is not that God has disappeared. We simply lack a "God" mindset. When we develop our sensitivity, we soon begin to see His work everywhere.

God is a jealous God (Exodus 20:5; 34:15). He desires nothing more than our full attention and commitment. And when we do that, we develop that "God Mindset" that leads us to constantly look for Him in all of life.

But how do we develop that "God Mindset?" Let me give you several thoughts:

- God says in Romans 12:2 that we are transformed by the renewing of the mind. Thus we must guard our minds constantly to keep evil, ungodly things out and allow good, Godly things in.
- Philippians 2:5 says that we are to allow the same mindset that was in Jesus to be in us. His mindset was one of total submission to the will of God.
- Proverbs 3:5-6 demands we put total trust in God, always turn to Him, and He will pinpoint a straight path for us to follow.

• Ephesians 5:18 commands us to be filled with the Spirit. This shows continuous action which means we must be totally submissive to the control of the Holy Spirit *CONSTANTLY!*

• Psalm 1:2-3 speaks to the fact that *IF* we delight ourselves in God's Word, He will bring forth His fruit from us. (Other passages also turn us to constant study and meditation on God's Word— 2 Tim. 2:15; 3:16-17.)

• In Philippians 2:3 Paul speaks of our lowliness of mind. This means humility. When we see God in all His holiness and ourselves in all our sin, we humble ourselves before Him and better develop that "God Mindset."

I'm sure you can come up with many more ways to help develop that "God Mindset" to keep you focused on Him. Let me know what you come up with!
