Charles Simpson, in *Pastoral Renewal*, writes:

I met a young man not long ago who dives for exotic fish for aquariums. He said one of the most popular aquarium fish is the shark. He explained that if you catch a small shark and confine it, it will stay a size proportionate to the aquarium. Sharks can be six inches long yet fully matured. But if you turn them loose in the ocean, they grow to their normal length of eight feet.

Question: How many "six-inch Christians" have you encountered that stayed "six-inch Christians" simply because they confined themselves to an aquarium-sized spiritual atmosphere rather than what God promises us in His Word? Isn't it so sad to see so many of God's children stay spiritual children rather than growing to spiritual adulthood?

God's Word is clear about how we grow and how we mature. Just a few of these thoughts will do:

- Study to show ourselves approved not to be ashamed as God's children (2 Tim. 2:15).
- Use His Word for doctrine, reproof, correction, and maturity (2 Tim. 3:16-17).
- Forgive as He forgives (Matt. 6:14-15; 18:22).
- Become conformed to the image of Jesus Christ (Rom. 8:29).

- Be active in church (Hebrews 10:25).
- Abide in Christ to bear fruit (John 15:5).
- Be His witnesses (Acts 1:8; Matt. 28:18-20).
- Pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17).
- Love one another (John 13:34-35).
- Esteem others more than yourself (Phil. 2:3).
- Be humble (1 Cor. 15:10; Ps. 25:9; Prov. 11:2).
- Don't gossip (Prov. 11:13; Rom 1:29; 1 Tim. 5:13).
- Don't quench God's Spirit (1 Thess. 5:19).
- Be filled with the Spirit (Eph. 5:18).

Much, much more could be added but you get the picture. Don't be a "six-inch Christian!" See you Sunday morning at 9:15 a.m. for Bible Study!
