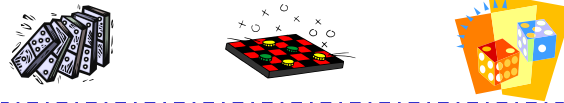

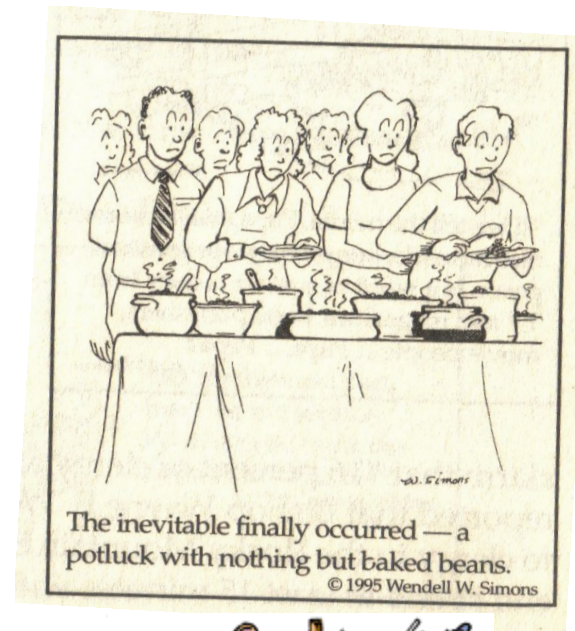

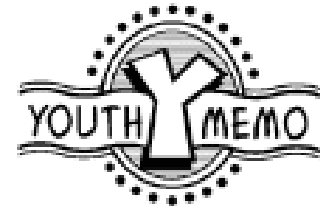

Return Service Requested



In the eleventh century, King Henry III of Bavaria grew tired of court life and the pressures of being a monarch. He made application to Prior Richard at a local monastery, asking to be accepted as a contemplative and spend the rest of his life in the monastery.

"Your Majesty," said Prior Richard, "do you understand that the pledge here is one of obedience? That will be hard because you have been a king."

"I understand, said Henry. "The rest of my life I will be obedient to you, as Christ leads you."

"Then I will tell you what to do," said Prior Richard. "Go back to your throne and serve faithfully in the place where God has put you."

When King Henry died, a statement was written: "The king learned to rule by being obedient."

When we tire of our roles and responsibilities, it helps to remember God has planted us in a certain place and told us to be a good accountant or teacher or mother or father. Christ expects us to be faithful where He puts us, and when He returns, we'll rule together with Him.

Question: Do you feel fulfilled spiritually in your life? Even further, do you feel you are in *THE* place of service God would have you? I don't know the percentage, but my guess is many don't have the spiritual fulfillment they should have.

Why, you may ask, is this true? I believe many things contribute to this uncertainty:

- Number one is a lack of obedience. Bloom where you are planted. Be obedient and God will lead you!
- Also, we often reverse our priorities, putting ours ahead of His. I often hear: I deserve it; I want it; they shouldn't have it ahead of me; etc.
- And then there's always this one: I simply don't have time. Didn't Jesus have time for you?
- I'll do something when work slows down, when the kids are grown, when I get myself straightened out, when I feel more prepared, etc., etc., etc.
- I'm simply not good enough. God wants what you have to take you and make you what He wants you to be—supernatural!

Question: Are you fulfilled spiritually in your life? Is it because of lack of obedience? Until you are obedient God cannot use you *AND* you will not feel fulfilled. Don't make excuses, become obedient.
