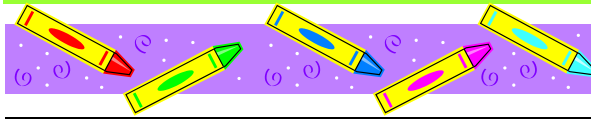

Don McCullough writes in *Waking from the American Dream*:

During World War II, England needed to increase its production of coal. Winston Churchill called together labor leaders to enlist their support. At the end of his presentation he asked them to picture in their minds a parade which he knew would be held in Piccadilly Circus after the war. First, he said, would come the sailors who had kept the vital sea lanes open. Then would come the soldiers who had come home from Dunkirk and then gone on to defeat Rommel in Africa. Then would come the pilots who had driven the Luftwaffe from the sky.

Last of all, he said, would come a long line of sweat-stained, soot-streaked men in miner's caps. Someone would cry from the crowd, "And where were you during the critical days of our struggle?"

And from ten thousand throats would come the answer, "We were deep in the earth with our faces to the coal."

Not all the jobs in a church are prominent and glamorous. But the people with their "faces to the coal" play a vital role in helping the church accomplish its mission.

Question: Do you have your "face to the coal?" This simply means you are investing your life in the lives of others by doing what God has called you to do. We can, and do, make all sorts of excuses as we ignore ministry and service: I'm just too busy...I'm not good enough...I simply can't do what others can do...I'll do it later...I've already done my part... But God says to us in 1 Corinthians 12: "The body is not one member but many...God has set the members every one in the body as it has pleased Him...and if they were all one member

where would the body be...those members who seem to be weaker or less necessary in fact are necessary...but God composed the body giving greater honor to that part which lacks it...there should be no schism in the body...if one member suffers all should...if one member is honored all should rejoice with it."

What is God saying? In this "war" we find ourselves engaged in, some are sailors, some soldiers, some pilots, and some are miners, BUT we are all, as the body of Christ, to keep our "faces to the coal."

And you? If everyone at S.V.B.C. did as you, where would we be? Let's all do our part, be that part God has appointed us to be, so our body here will be all God wants us to be! Then, as our verses said, it will please Him!
